Step 1 - roll two dice for result of 2-12																					
If within PB range, Column C, then next roll will be on pitcher's card. If not, will be on batters card.																					
Step 2 - roll two 8-sided dice for 11-88. Roll between 11 and the 1B number is a single. The other numbers show the HIGHEST number in range for different results.

Under simple rules, if 2-12 roll in step 1 is a 4 (for Step 3 (simple rules) To try to steal or runner go an extra base, roll a 6-sided die. "6" is an OUT. OBR/SP AA steals or extra base on 1-5, A 1-4, B 1-3 , C 1-2 & D 1. On out, batter out instead, on hit runner 1 more base than batter Step 4 (simple rules) - If the 2-12 rule is either a 2 or a 12 (but not 3 to 11) check again for error. Roll both 6-sided die again and their HIGHER die is the player who might make an error (6=ss, 5=3b,4=2b, 3=1b, 2=c, 1+p) Step 4a - Roll one 8-sided die and if it is EQUAL TO OR LOWER than the fielder's error number it is an error. (e.g. an 8-sided die roll of 3 means an E-0, E-1 or E2 is NOT an error, but an E-3, E-4, or higher is)
